

GUESS A FRUIT

RULES

Guess a Fruit is a guessing game for 5 players.

One player has to guess. The other four players have to – without showing their cards – describe what they see on their cards so that the one who is guessing can figure (classify) the fruit.

Players can take turns to be the one who is guessing.

The game has two important rules:

1. Only the one who is guessing can name fruits.
2. You may not show your card to others.

There are a total of 8 fruits to guess.
